Exciting news about our neighbouring parish of The Ascension, Hulme: The Church Commissioners have awarded the diocese a grant to transform The Ascension into a hub for the HeartEdge network which has come out of St Martin in the Fields in London.

The new priest in The Ascension is the Revd Azariah France-Williams. St Ann's Rector, Nigel Ashworth and our other neighbouring Rector, Andy Salmon of Sacred Trinity in Salford, have been on the steering group helping the project to achieve this support.

This offers St Ann's the chance to be part of a network which will build partnership in such areas as working with the visual arts, music and digital communications. Watch this space!





Remembering Ann Bland

St Ann's Church was consecrated and opened to the public on July 17th 1712 - 308 years ago next Friday. It is amazing to think that the whole church was paid for by one woman - Lady Ann Bland. She is buried at St James's Church in Didsbury and there is a memorial to her inside the church. Every year a group from St Ann's gathers on our anniversary at St James's. Prayers are said and a posy is put on Lady Ann's memorial. If you want to join in this year just come along to St James's at 11.00 am on Friday. You will be most welcome.
